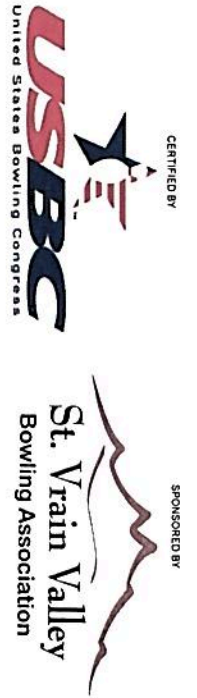

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. USBC rules shall govern this tournament unless otherwise clarified below.
2. Entry will be open to all 2017-18 USBC members in good standing. Every singles and doubles entrant must bowl both the singles and doubles events. Every entrant must be a member of the St. Vrain Valley Bowling Association prior to bowling the event.
3. The tournament shall consist of a five-bowler team event, singles, doubles, and all events. Three consecutive games shall be bowled in each event and total pins shall decide the winner. When a bowler competes more than once, the first score in each event shall count towards the all events score.
4. Entrants shall use the following average rules to determine a tournament average in the following order:
 - a. Highest LBA/LWBA sanctioned Fall League average as of the end of last season (2016-17) of 21 games or more.
 - b. If no Fall League average exists, the highest sanctioned Summer League average of 21 games or more.
 - c. If no 2016-17 average exists, highest current SVVBA USBC sanctioned league average for the current season (2017-18) of 21 games or more. League sheets through January 31, 2018 will be used to determine current average.
 - d. If current average from rule 4c is 10 pins or more higher than the LBA/LWBA book average (2016-17), then the bowler will enter with current season average.
 - e. If no average is determined from rules 4a through 4d, bowler shall enter with an average of 220.
 - f. Each bowler may contact USBC HQ in writing with a request for average relief from USBC Rule 319 for average determinations. The Tournament Director, with guidance from SVVBA USBC Board volunteers, may determine an average different than the rules described in sections 4a through 4e. The bowler has the right to refuse the average determination and be refunded entry fees.
5. The tournament will be handicapped at 90% of the difference between 220 and the average determined in rule 4 above.
6. Entry fee will be \$22.00 per bowler per event:
 - a. Bowling Lineage.....\$9.00 per event
 - b. Prize Fund\$11.00 per event
 - c. Trophy & Exp.....\$2.00 per event
 - d. Optional Side Events...\$5.00 per event (All Events Scratch/Handicap, Scratch Singles, Scratch Doubles (430))
7. If optional Scratch Doubles Event is selected by two bowlers, the sum of their entry averages, as determined in rule 4, will be a maximum of 430.
 - a. Only one scratch doubles entry per bowler/squad may be entered.
 - b. Scratch doubles entries must be bowling together in the tournament as doubles partners in the current squad.
8. A substitute will not be required to reimburse the original entrant the entry fee paid, nor shall the substitute be expected to give the original entrant any prize money or trophy won unless otherwise decided by the team. All-Events entries are forfeited for the original bowler if a sub is used for any event.
9. The lineup will be the same as shown on the entry form. Changes are discouraged as they can impact the accuracy of scoring review.
10. Entries will be scheduled according to request if possible and in the order received. The schedule will not be changed by the Tournament Director except for emergencies.
11. Late arriving bowlers will have until the first shot in the 4th frame of any game to participate and will be allowed to make up frames 1 through 3. Any bowlers arriving after the 3rd frame will get zeroes for all frames prior to the present frame being bowled and may continue from that point.
12. Singles are bowled immediately following doubles. If a partner in the doubles event has not arrived by the beginning of the event and a substitute is not available; the bowler present will be permitted to bowl their half in the doubles event in order to qualify for all events.
13. In the team event, the captain will check in the entire team 30 minutes prior to the scheduled bowling time. All bowlers in singles and doubles events must check in 30 minutes prior to bowling time.
14. Any protests affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director before the tournament prize payments are made. **ERRORS IN SCORING WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED UNLESS REPORTED TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER YOU HAVE BOWLED ANY EVENT. ANY QUESTIONS REGARDING SCORES OR POSITION STANDINGS, CONTACT THE TOURNAMENT OFFICE IMMEDIATELY.**
15. Any and all ties other than first place shall be treated and paid as ties by the SVVBA USBC.
16. Prizes and awards will be paid out in a ratio of at least 1 in 6 paid entries.
17. Official scores will be the Automatic Scoring Printout.
18. The Board of Directors of the St. Vrain Valley Bowling Association USBC shall have the power to hear and act on all protests regarding the rules of the St. Vrain Valley Bowling Association USBC Open City Tournament.
